There's some cute videos on there, although it's not going completely smoothly for the first baby falcon (called an "eyasses," actually). In one video, "Mamma Falcon tries her best to force the new baby back into its egg, less than three hours after it was born." BBDO had better guard its National Geographic account closely in the wake of this.

Metro Detroit marketing firm spots falcons nesting on roof, sets up live video stream and tumblr

Campbell Ewald says two adult peregrine falcons are nesting over three eggs, which are expected to hatch in mid-May, atop the roof of its Warren office.

Naturally, the company has wasted little time marketing this natural phenomenon. In addition to a live video stream of the birds, the firm has set up its #CEFalcons tumblr page at

The video stream shows a close up of one of the birds sitting on the eggs, jerking its head around at random, as birds do.

The Warren office is not a new home for the falcons. Employees first posted the birds there in 2004. Then in 2006, an employee researched a nest box for falcons, and subsequently constructed one on the roof.

The company says local DNR officials expect the birds to return annually now, but this will likely be the last year they are greeted by Campbell Ewald employees. In March, the firm announced it was moving its 600 employees to a newly renovated space at the former J.L. Hudson Warehouse, which is attached to Ford Field in downtown Detroit.

The company will make the physical move by December 2013 or January 2014.



A camera is giving the world a live view of the falcons as they are perched on the roof of the Campbell Ewald building.


The birds have been calling the building home dating back to at least 2004.
